

2nd International Meeting: London, the 22nd, 23rd and 24th September 2006

The second International Meeting of the AGIS program took place in London the 22nd, 23rd and 24th September 2006.

After the meetings that took place inside each National Steering Committee, the partners of the project have met themselves to follow the discussions and the situation analysis in topic of the collection of the word of child victim of sexual violence.

During this meeting, the participants had the opportunity of meeting the new partner that have taken the place of the Austrian association in the project; it is the Belgian association SOS Enfants constituted by a multidisciplinary team, really implicated in the follow up of children victims, represented, during this Conference, by a pedopsychiatrist, expert on the subject matter.

The meeting turned toward the discussion on the different systems of hearing of the child victim of sexual violence in order to formulate some concretes proposals and common standards concerning the good practices, able to take to the harmonization of the norms concerned despite the differences existing between each country.

A visit into an interviewing centre was organised by the English partners; this experience has given a most concrete character to the thoughts elaborated during the Conference.

Some specifics points had been discussed that will constitute the leading lines to direct the reflection inside the National Steering Committees.

The next International Meeting will take place in Florence in May 2007. The Italian partner, who will organize this Conference, proposed the leading lines of this future meeting.
