

INTERNATIONAL MEETING

FLORENCE the 11th, 12th and 13th May 2007



The third International Meeting of the AGIS programme on « The situation analysis of good practice in the field of collection of evidence and hearing of child victims of maltreatment, in order to establish European cooperation between the police and the legal system » took place the 11th, 12th and 13th May 2007 in Florence, Italy, at the Istituto degli Innocenti.

The first day of this meeting was opened to a public of Italian experts who had been intervened in the debate of the two round tables organised around the hearing of children victims. The principal topic of the first round table was about « the child's hearing in the legal system. A comparison of different European experiences », and the second one: « a clinical perspective on the needs of child victims of sexual abuse involved in the judicial procedures ».

During the other two days, the partners followed their debate on the development of the hearing system of children victims of maltreatment and/or sexual violence through common programme of training, prevention, awareness and European cooperation.

The guide lines of the work that precede the AGIS Final Conference in Paris at the end of the 2007 were evocated and some propositions had already been approved.
