**(England - Essex):**

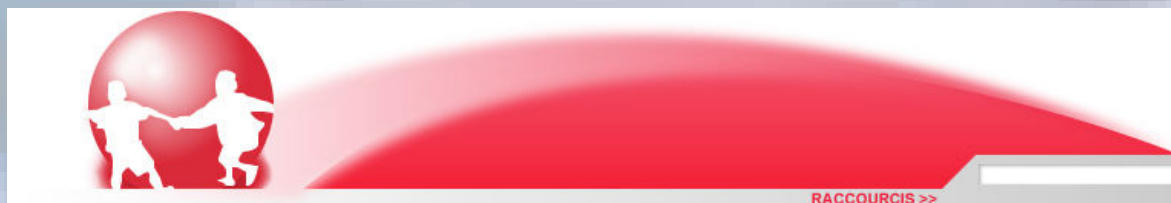
The Children's Legal Centre, with the status of an association, has been founded in 1981 to promote children's rights and to prevent the social exclusion of children and young people.
